Can you help children in Uganda love reading ?



Then read on

How can you study and pass exams if you don't get access to books? Or if you have poor reading skills? Or if you have no light at home to read by?

For children living in rural Uganda, we provide a Library and Study Centre at our Development Centre in Kamuli, giving them access to books until 9pm at night.

But for students living in the surrounding areas we have to take the books to them. To do this we provide secondary schools with a book box—filled with books linked to the Ugandan National Curriculum. Each book box costs about £350.

Could you as a group help us? A monthly donation of £10 from 3 book clubs would allow at least 500 more students to improve their reading skills and exam results. Turn over to find out how you can help improve the lives of children in rural Uganda



All the books are selected by the Head Teachers and comply with the Ugandan National Curriculum. Particularly popular are the revision notes that the students use prior to their national exams. Using these improves their success rates and their chances of taking up employment or going on to further education. Having seen the success of the project with the secondary school students—we are looking at introducing a similar scheme next year into Primary schools.

What you need to do

1. Decide on the name for your Book Club.
2. Nominate a person who will be your contact with us (your collector). She/he can download the form our website [here](#).
3. Decide how much you would like to give individually per meeting eg £1 / £1.50 / £ 2
4. Add your details to the form that the collector has. Once completed he/she needs to send it to the address below. This will allow us to claim Gift Aid if you are a taxpayer (adding an extra 25%) on your donation.
5. Your collector can decide whether he/she will either send us a cheque after each meeting to:
